

**(RULES TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTITUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE MEDICAL COLLEGE, RANGOON.)**

No.62.- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 (2) of the University of Rangoon Act, 1920, the Governor hereby makes the following rules to provide for the constitution of the Governing Body of the Medical College, Rangoon. Sub-section (1) (a) of Statute No. 54 of the Statutes of the University of Rangoon is hereby repealed:-

**RULES TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTITUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE MEDICAL COLLEGE,  
RANGOON.**

**I.- Constitution.**

1. The Governing Body of the Medical College, Rangoon, shall consist of the following members, namely:-
  - (1) The Vice-Chancellor.
  - (2) The Inspector-General of Civil Hospitals, Burma.
  - (3) The Principal, Medical College.
  - (4)- (9) Six members appointed by the Government of Burma of whom not less than three shall be registered medical practitioners who are in possession of medical degrees granted by a University.
  - (10)- (11) Two members appointed by the Chancellor of whom one shall be a member of the Council of the University and the other a member of the Senate of the University.
  - (12) One member nominated by the Burma Medical Council, such member being a registered medical practitioner in possession of a medical degree granted by a University.
  - (13) One member of the Council of the University elected by the Council.
  - (14) One member elected by the Lecturers and Assistant Lecturers of the Medical College.
  - (15) One member elected by the Medical College Society, such member being a graduate in medicine who is no longer a student of the University.
2. The Vice-Chancellor shall be the President of the Governing Body. There shall also be a Vice-President elected by the members from among themselves. The Principal shall be ex-officio Executive Member of the Governing Body.
