(The Provisional Recruitment Rules, 1939.)

Rangoon, the 20th May 1939.

No. 55. - The Governor makes the following rules under section 98 of the Government of Burma Act, 1935, to regulate temporarily certain conditions of service of future recruits to services and posts:-

1. These rules may be called **“The Provisional Recruitment Rules, 1939”**.
2. These rules shall come into force at once and shall remain in force in respect of each service or post until such time as a new scale or scales of pay are fixed for such service or post.
3. These rules shall apply to all services and posts within the rule-making power of the Governor with the exception of-
 - (i) posts borne on ministerial or menial establishments,
 - (ii) services and posts which are solely employed in connexion with the functions of the Governor under section 7 of the Government of Burma Act, and
 - (iii) officers of the civil police below the rank of Deputy Superintendent and officers of the military police below the rank of Naib-Commandant.
4. All future appointments shall be on a provisional footing, that is to say, in an officiating capacity, except in respect of promotions and transfers within the same service.
5. A Government servant appointed under these rules shall retain a lien on his substantive post, if any.
6. These rules supersede, in respect of the persons affected by them, all existing rules under which sanctioned scales of pay and allowances have been fixed:

Provided that in the case of a Government servant whose pay is fixed under the provisions of the Future Recruitment (Temporary) Rules prior to the date on which these present rules come into force, he shall, notwithstanding the provisions of Rules 7 and 8, continue to draw the pay so fixed until a new scale has been fixed for his service or post.

7. The pay of a person who is not already in the permanent service of Government and who is appointed to a service or post shall be as provisionally fixed by the Governor and no compensatory local allowance shall be admissible except by special order of the Governor.
 8. The pay of a person who was in the permanent service of Government on the date on which these rules come into effect and who is either promoted or transferred to another service or to a post outside his own service shall be as provisionally fixed by the Governor and no compensatory local allowance shall be admissible except by special orders of the Governor.
- N. B. - This rule does not apply to officers who are entitled under the conditions of their service to receive a specific scale of pay on promotion to a higher service. In such cases the officer shall draw that specific scale, on promotion, as a personal scale.
