

No. 143 (FORESTS).- The following additional rule, numbered 16 (c), is made by the Chief Commissioner under section 34 (2) (c) of the Upper Myanmar Forest Regulation, 1887, and is published for general information :-

Rule 16 (c).- The felling or girdling for trade purposes of pyinma, pyinkado, ingyin, or thitya trees within the limits of the Pyinmana and Yamethin districts of the Eastern division is prohibited, except under and subject to the conditions of a license issued by the officer in charge of the Pyinmana Forest division. Such license shall be in the following form :-

APPENDIX 10.

Trade License to fell and remove Pyinma, Pyinkado, Ingyin, or Thitya trees within the Pyinmana and Yamethin districts.

LICENSE to fell the trees specified on the reverse and to remove the timber to is granted under the Upper Myanmar Forest Rules for months from this date to of on payment of Rs. subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That only trees marked for felling by a Forest Officer in the areas named on the reverse are to be felled.
- 2. That no trees are felled or removed after the time for which this permit is granted shall have lapsed.
- 3. That in addition to the amount paid for this license duty at the rate prescribed under Rule 16 of the Upper Myanmar Forest Rules shall be paid on the timber on arrival at and that the timber shall not be removed from until such duty has been paid in full.
- 4. That breach of the above conditions will render the holder liable to forfeiture of his license and confiscation of the timber as well as to the punishment prescribed in the Forest Rules.
