Amending Law

No. 263. - The following rules for the examination of officers of the Irrigation Department, Myanmar, whom it is proposed to invest with Magisterial powers, have received the sanction of the Lieutenant-Governor:-

I. - The examination will consist of questions on-

(1) The Myanmar Canal Act, 1905, and the rules made thereunder.  
(2) So much of the undermentioned portions of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1898, as relates to the powers and procedure of Magistrates of the 2nd or 3rd class-  
Part I.

Part II, Chapter II (except sub-heads D, E and F) and Chapter III.

Part III, Chapters IV and V.

Part VI, Chapters XXIV and XXVIII.

Part IX, Chapter XLVI.

(3) The whole of the undermentioned Chapters of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1898-

Part III, Chapter VI.

Part VI, Chapters XV, XVI, XVII, XX, XXV and XXVI.

Part IX, Chapters XXXIX and XLII.

(4) The undermentioned enactments, rules and directions relating to land revenue business in Upper Myanmar-

(a) Directions to Settlement Officers for Upper Myanmar.  
(b) Directions to Revenue Officers concerning supplementary survey in Upper Myanmar.  
(c) The Upper Myanmar Land and Revenue Regulation, 1889, sections 23 to 26 and 32.  
(d) The general rules under the Upper Myanmar Land and Revenue Regulation, 1889, Chapters V, VI, VIII, IX, X (Rules 68 and 69), XI, XII, and XIV (Rules 96-98 and 122-141).

II. - The examination will be held at the same time and place as the examinations of Assistant Commissioners and Extra Assistant Commissioners held in June and November.

III. - A paper of six questions will be set on the Code of Criminal Procedure [Rule I (2) and (3)] and a paper of six questions on the Canal Act and Rules and Revenue Law [Rule I (3) and (4)]. In order to pass candidates will be required to obtain half the maximum marks in each paper.

IV. - The Superintending Engineer, 'Irrigation Circle, Myanmar, will forward to the President of the Central Examination Committee, not later than the 1st May or 1st October, as the case may be, a list in the form below, of the officers who will appear at the examination:-
